Graduate-level Social Work interns work alongside our licensed clinicians (LSW/LCSW) to provide therapeutic support to survivors of domestic violence. This internship offers an opportunity to develop clinical skills in a supportive, trauma-informed setting.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist LSW/LCSW in planning and facilitating therapeutic activities and support groups.
- Observe and participate in individual and group sessions under supervision.
- Learn and apply evidence-based interventions for trauma recovery and empowerment.
- Support clients in developing coping strategies and emotional regulation skills.
- Complete documentation and progress notes in compliance with agency standards.
- Collaborate with the clinical team to ensure holistic care for survivors.

- Enrollment in a master's program in Social Work (MSW) with interest in clinical practice.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to engage with diverse populations.
- Commitment to trauma-informed and client-centered approaches.
